

Explore the Passage



Matthew 5:4-5

4 *"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.*

5 *"Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.*

What are good and bad things that motivate us to obedience?
What should be our motivation?

Verse 4 promises God's comfort to those who are mourning.
How have you experienced God's comfort in a time of mourning?

Christ declares that the meek are blessed but meekness doesn't seem like an attribute that we should strive for but in what ways is meekness Christ-like?

We not only mourn over loss but we also mourn over sin. What are pharisaical or wrong ways we can respond to conviction of sin? What is the right way to respond? *See Psalm 51 for help with this question*
