FAITH WENGER (neck surgery) is recovering and regaining strength. She's still on pain medications, but can tell there's some improvement since the surgery. Home health determined she will not have therapy until her neck brace comes off. She had a follow-up and x-ray yesterday.

EMMETT ADKINS (broken kneecap / surgery) went to the doctor yesterday and received a good report. The knee is healing nicely and he no longer has to keep his leg straight and propped up. The next steps are to gradually bend the knee: at a 30o angle for two weeks, a 60o angle for two weeks, then a 90o angle for two weeks. Thank you for your continued prayers for his full healing and mobility. *(Emmett is still in Florida with son, David. Emmett's house sold quickly and they should be closing in 3 weeks. This is a huge answer to prayers!)*

VELMA SHINN has not been feeling well since the first of the year, experiencing several infections, stomach problems, and high blood pressure. Her circulation, thyroid and heart are good. PTL! She's been taking a blood pressure medication that has worked well for her so far, but will have to begin taking the generic form soon. Please pray that it will work just as well without any adverse reaction.

BEN HARDIN will have separate surgeries in late June, a week apart, to remove two skin cancers on his head.

BOYD & DONNA HARGRAVES request our continued prayers. Donna was able to find employment working third shift. This is an answer to prayers. Boyd has not yet been approved for unemployment benefits but is appealing the decision. Boyd is seeing a doctor this week to try and determine the cause for his ongoing hot and flushing face.
